BERNHEIM's Casual Collection Pinotage 2010

Bernheim Wines produces red wines from two farms in the famous Paarl region – one close to the town of Paarl and the other in the newly formed Voor Paardeberg ward, already gaining a reputation as the ward for quality wines.

The 2010 season was winemaker Jacques Kruger's first vintage in which he made a Pinotage using only grapes from the Voor Paardeberg farm.

Pinotage is a true South African variety cloned from Pinot Noir and Hermitage in 1925 by professor A I Perold.

Wine Making Details

The grapes were allowed to reach optimum ripeness before being hand harvested. Careful selection in the vineyard resulted with only the best grapes being used for this wine. After de-stalking the mash was kept cold in 10 ton fermenters for two days before the yeast was added. Fermentation was allowed to complete before the skins were pressed. The resulting wine has rich fruity crushed berry flavours, complemented by hints of banana and ripe plum.
